

NOTES FOR MULTIPLE-USER INSTALLS OF LERTAP 5.10

Installing a version of Lertap 5.10 for use with Excel 2010 or Excel 2013 on a multiple-user Windows computer requires a bit of special attention.

The install should be done by someone with administrator rights on the computer.

On a multiple-user machine, the Lertap system is best placed in the Public Documents folder, for example in:

C:\Users\Public\Documents

When Lertap 5.10 is first installed, and the Lertap5.xlsm file is opened with either Excel 2010 or Excel 2013, it should say that it is running as the 'Mini' version. This is a fully-functional version, but limited to processing no more than 50 data records.

If users want to be able to process more than 50 records (as most of them do), Lertap 5.10 should be upgraded to the full, unrestricted version. Doing so requires obtaining an "unlock code"; instructions for doing this may be [found here](#). This should be done by the person who installed Lertap, someone with administrator rights, and it's *important that it be done before anyone else logs into the computer*.

Once Lertap 5.10 has been unlocked (or "activated"), the administrator should log off and watch as another user logs in and attempts to run Lertap. It is likely that users may need some assistance when it comes to locating the Lertap5.xlsm file in Public Documents. Perhaps a special shortcut can be installed on the user's desktop to help out.
